Performance Reporting PC-MH Initiative

Goal – Create the capability to assess and report on the performance of individual physicians, their practice groups and the physician organization (PO) with regard to the care provided to the population of patients with chronic conditions.

Description – POs should develop performance reporting. They are expected to work with their Practice Units to complete all Initiative Tasks within **4 years** of the start of continuous participation. Practice Units may implement the Initiative Tasks in any sequence they choose. Tasks include:

- Establish key indicators for the four major chronic conditions
- Implement capability to generate performance reports by indicator at the PO, individual provider and clinic or Practice Unit level for each condition
- Implement capability to generate performance reports for all chronic conditions
- Fully validate and reconcile data to ensure accuracy
- Implement capability to generate summary and trend performance reports (e.g., dashboard reports, score cards)
- Implement capability to generate performance reports on pertinent quality indicators for both adult and pediatric patients
- Implement capability to generate performance reports for all preventive services
- Establish interface enabling reports to include additional clinical information: lab values, physiological parameters from electronic records, medication lists/filled medications from E-Rx database, emergency department and urgent care records, inpatient hospitalizations
- Establish interface enabling reports to include information on services provided by specialists

Incentive Design - The first incentive payment will be based solely on the PO's participation. Subsequent payments will be based on a PO participation component and Practice Unit performance.
